



# Gymcats Dance

## Hair and Dress Code



Gymcats Logo Leotard is required to perform in the Holiday Show and should be worn to class, although not required.

Proper attire, proper shoes, and pulled back hair are a **MUST** for good training.

### Hair

Please use hair barrettes, and styling gel to hold hair in place, so your child's hair is not a distraction while she is learning.

Hair is to be pulled up off the neck and away from the face.

If hair is too short, it must be pulled back with barrettes.

### Attire

#### 2 - 7 year old Combo classes:

Gymcats Logo Leotard recommended but not required.

Any style or color leotard. Ballet skirts required in ballet.

Skirt with tights or jazz pants required for tap, black jazz pants required for jazz.

Ballet and Tap shoes required. Sox or tights required.

#### Ballet- all levels:

**NO HOUSE SLIPPERS!**

Gymcats Logo Leotard recommended but not required.

Black Leotard, Black Ballet Skirt, Pink tights, Pink Ballet shoes.

Hair up in a Bun. **NO EXCEPTIONS!**

#### Jazz:

Gymcats Logo Leotard recommended but not required.

All Jazz levels must wear black jazz pants and any color leotard with black jazz shoes.

No crop tops, loose t-shirts or shorts will be allowed to be worn in class.

During cold weather, students may wear warm-up clothes.

#### Tap:

Gymcats Logo Leotard recommended but not required.

Comfortable dance attire. No pants that drag on the floor, feet must be visible. Tap shoes required.

#### Hip Hop:

Comfortable clothing. No tight jeans. No skirts, no boots, no flip flops, no elevated shoes of any sort.

Sneakers required. Pant bottoms must be below the knee. Baggy clothing OK.

#### Lyrical

Comfortable dance clothing, bare feet or foot undies required.
